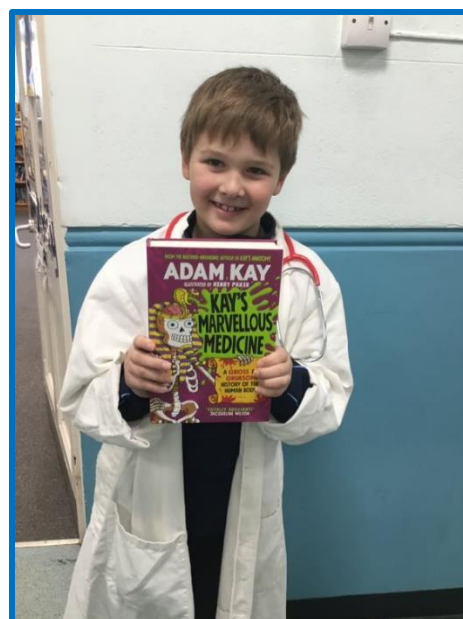

Years 3 and 4 were delighted to have members of The Babcock Environmental and STEM Team read to them on World Book Day.



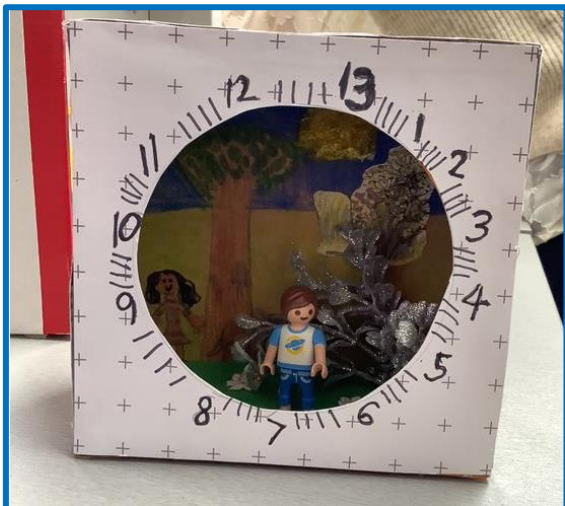

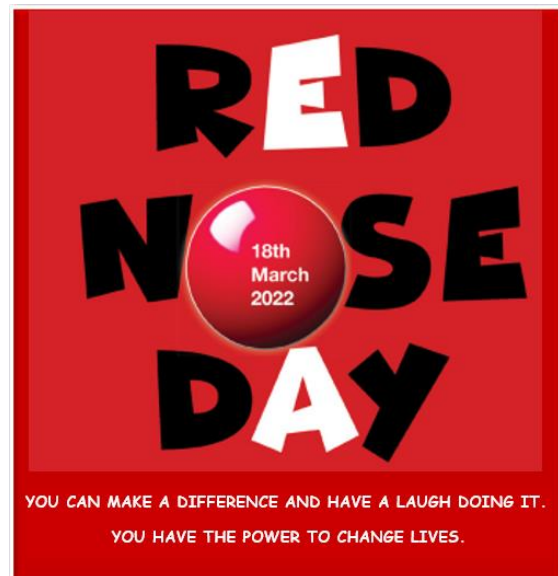
British Science Week
