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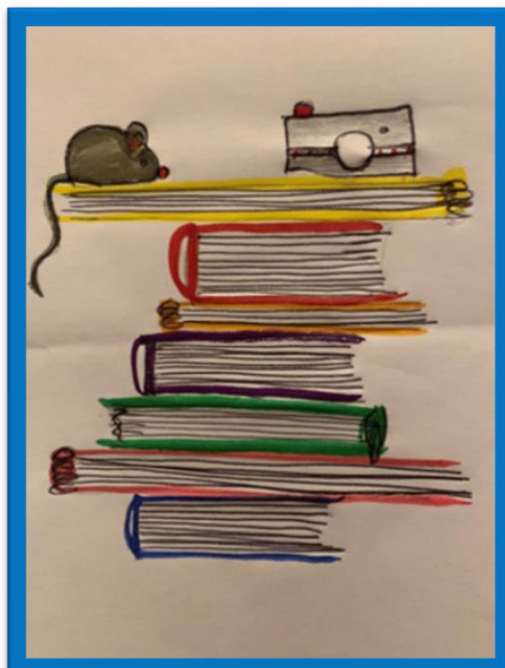
Go Read Competition Winners

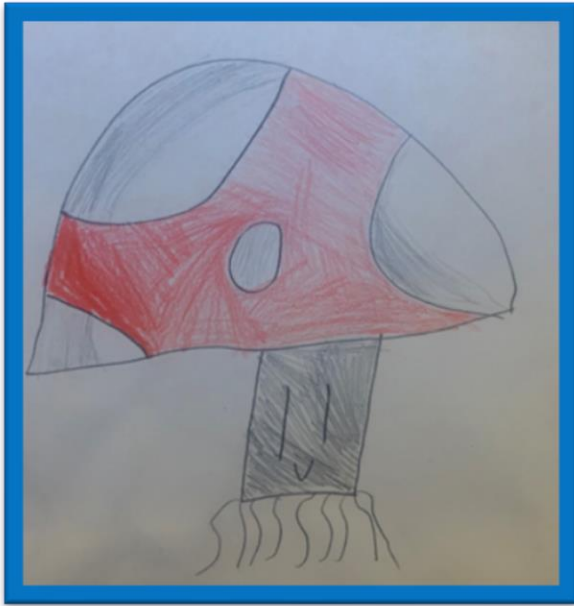

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Duplo Towers

Our Reception children have been building some amazing towers. The children have been reading and enjoying the story, 'The Little Red Hen', and built a tower to depict the windmill from the story.



Animal Movements

In Year 1 the children have been using their understanding of animals to support their movements in dance. They have been creating balances at high and low levels to show both small and big animals, and combining this with movements to show how their animal might travel in order to create a sequence.



Bread Tasting

In recent lessons as part of Design and Technology, our Year 2s participated in bread tasting. The children sampled: white, whole meal, baguette, sour dough and Naan breads, after which they evaluated the taste, texture, appearance and smell of the breads.



Indoor Athletics Competition

Recently, a team of children represented Hyde Park at the Indoor Athletics competition. After taking part in a series of running, jumping and throwing events, our team came third! Here they are celebrating their bronze medals. A big well done to our team!



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Investigating Friction

Within their Science lessons, Year 3 have been investigating friction. Whilst learning about different forces, the children carried out a comparative test involving pulling an object along different surfaces. First, the children made a prediction, and then they investigated. The children used Newton metres to measure the force and recorded their results in a table.
